# Jr. Warden's report for August 16, 2020

There has been activity around the church grounds that I find exciting!

The "Hands On" preschool has started a limited program in lieu of the full-time school. Most all of their activities are outside. They're using the playground area a lot and they purchased and installed a new vinyl awning for the play structure. They're also using the Courtyard rain garden as a kind of forest path and planted the raised bed areas. I think that Jennifer mentioned to me that they're limiting classes to 10 kids.

Equally as exciting is the overhaul of the Meditation Garden! Randy and Karen Dollar provided the guidance on the project, along with work from Barbara and Babe Taylor and Elena Smiley. All the brush and weeds were cleared from the area, and the ivy trimmed. The termite-riddled tree stump that had been in the Garden area for years was cut up by Randy and put in the dumpster. A 12'x25' green, indoor/ outdoor carpet piece was installed in the area, which helps define the space. I encourage the Vestry to take a look at the area and admire the work!

Tavish, our lawn mowing guy, has been keeping up on the lawn. He's scheduled to mow down the dandelions again next week. I'll be trimming along the parking lot curb.

I'm still intending on doing some outside painting on the doors and trim. This would entail going through all our old paint stored in the downstairs janitor closet, so we can see if there's usable paint for projects.

Also, I'm slowly reassembling the upstairs ladies room after painting. I've got some of the fixtures back up and plan on doing some more this next week.
