Approval of August 12 minutes [Barbara]

Music program update [Barbara]

- On Wednesday, 5 September Ben accepted the updated job description we discussed at our 2 September special vestry meeting.
- Barbara and Ben created a behavioral covenant specifically for the choir, which members must sign to join the choir.

- We need to raise and finalize rates for camps very soon, as organizations are anxious to lock space down for summer camps.

- We discussed the need for changing the culture of volunteering at St. David's, and decided that we should talk more about this at the retreat.
